

10th Polaris Volunteers

Local volunteer squadrons serve as recruiting and training units for the NTF. Using nationalist and xeno-phobic propaganda the NTF uses these units to put its eager (and sometimes fanatical) recruits to the test in field. Pilots who show aptitude and initiative are eventually transferred to regular combat units. These units are usually divided into ten smaller „squadrons“ each under the supervision of seasoned pilots, but at top have only about 60 „fresh“ pilots spread out across each deployment. Equipment and size of the „squadrons“ vary depending on the deployment site (most equipment and pilots go to the „squadrons attached to military vessels or installations).

71st Liberators

A group of pilots who are either xenophobic to the extreme or uncaring about the lives of non-terrans. Some pilots in the Liberators have begun viewing fighting Vasudans as a sadistic sport.

The unit was involved in several engagements in the Deneb theater of operations during which pilots actively targeted civilians. According to the GTVA warcrimes tribunal of 2368 all officers associated with the Liberators are either guilty of war crimes or accessory to said crimes.

Garde

The small group of fighters attached to the Icenii officially form a squadron called „Garde“ which operates not entirely inside the NTF chain of command.
